FORMAT & FEES

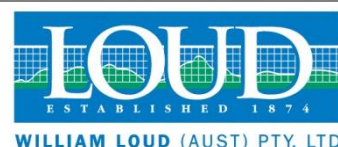
Four players per team. 6 doubles, 6 game sets, tie breakers at 5 all.
