



2023 AUSTRALIAN CLAYCOURT CHAMPIONSHIPS: WILLOW KELLY & RIELLE ARMSTRONG

In amazing news for tennis in the Bendigo region, two local stars will be part of a field of the best 32 girls from across the country in the 12 & under age group at the 2023 Australian Claycourt Championships!

Willow Kelly was one of 23 direct acceptances nationally for the event thanks to her high national age group ranking. Willow has already competed at the 2023 Australian Grasscourt Championships held in January at Wodonga, finishing in 14th place. During 2022, Willow won both the 2022 Bendigo Strategem Junior & Open Zone Series Event (July) and the Bendigo September Junior & Open Zone Series, in the 14 & under girls events. Willow also competed for Team Vic at the national Bruce Cup team championships.

Another local, Rielle Armstrong, has now joined Willow in the acceptance list for the claycourt championships by winning the Victorian Qualifying event on the weekend of 25-26 March at Dingley Tennis Club. In a high pressure elimination format, Rielle was one of 16 girls playing off for just one available qualifying position, having to win four matches in a row. Unseeded, and the only country girl in the event, Rielle's dramatic success included saving a match point in round 1 before prevailing against the number one seed, and then saving four more match points in the final before winning it 2-6 7-6 6-3.

The 2023 Australian Claycourt Championships will be held in Canberra from 18-24 April. It is an exciting opportunity for both local 12 year olds. Willow and Rielle competed as teammates for SG Miss Hits in the 2022-23 BTA A Grade Open Junior Pennant. When in Canberra, as well as each vying for the title of national singles champion, the two friends will be able to take their local partnership to the national stage by playing together for the title of Australian claycourt doubles champions!

PAT CASH CUP - TEAM EVENT

On the weekend of 25-26 February, 16 juniors (including 10 BTA Pennant players), travelled to the grass courts of Horsham Lawn Tennis Club to represent the Loddon Campaspe Region at the 2023 Pat Cash Cup.

In each round, each player played one singles set and one mixed doubles set. In round 1, Loddon Campaspe started strongly with a win against Mornington Peninsula, 14 sets to 10. Highlights of this round included Georgia's wins in singles and doubles (with Silas), and Keira's singles win, which were all against higher rated opponents.

Round 2 saw our team face a powerful outfit from Melbourne's Eastern Region (the eventual runners-up). We competed very strongly but went down 22-2. Rielle and Eli came up with our two wins. Rielle was undefeated in singles across the event, and the Eli/Rielle doubles pairing were also undefeated across their four matches. Cielo and Bronte fought hard to take their Eastern Region doubles opponents to a tiebreak.

Round 3, delayed until Sunday morning, completed the round robin stage against the locals, Wimmera region. Loddon overcame Wimmera 14-10, which secured second position in our group. Cielo's fighting tiebreak win was a highlight, as was the close 18/u clash between Silas and Wimmera's best junior player.

In the playoff round, Loddon was pitted against Goulburn region, a mixed team that included 10 players from Melbourne. Matilda and Bronte pulled off upset wins against top metro players, and there were some very tight losses in others. However, Loddon ended up going down 14-10.

The weekend was finished off with a round of friendly, same gender doubles matches against Mornington Peninsula. This was agreed to be played instead of an official 7th/8th place playoff, with the exhibition-style format bringing out a few new tactics, including a few underarm serves from both teams!

Loddon's finished equal 7th (of 13 teams), which was the highest of the five country-only teams. Congratulations to all players on outstanding play, sportsmanship and support over the whole weekend.


